## SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP) ACADEMIC PLAN - ADVISING FORM

The federal government (law 34 CFR 668.34) says that colleges must get an Academic Plan from students who do not meet the university's academic progress rules, called SAP (Satisfactory Academic Progress).

**Students: Y**ou need to fill out this form with your plan for the next three school terms (must start with the term for which you are requesting funding). For each class, include:

- The course name and number
- How many credits it's worth
- The grade you expect to earn

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Then, figure out your expected GPA based on your planned grades. Only the classes you need to graduate can be counted for financial aid. This form must be signed by you and your Academic Advisor.

**Academic Advisors:** Federal rules require that S&T's Student Financial Services office collects an Academic Plan from students who have not met SAP, as defined by the U.S. Department of Education. This is different from academic probation. Please check the student's plan below to make sure it's realistic and includes only the classes needed for their degree. If it looks accurate, sign and date the form. Without this signed form, the student cannot receive federal financial aid for their next term.
